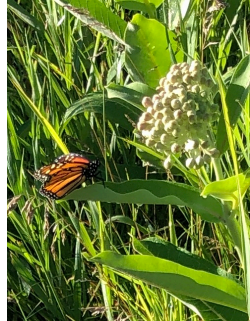

Common Loon Celebrating Life in the Boundary Waters

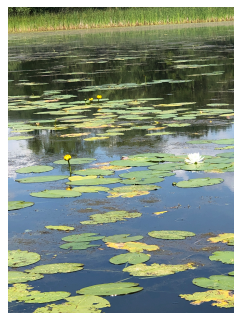

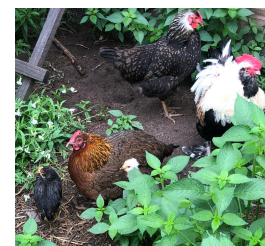
